3. ACQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCES

The holder of the certificate is qualified to:

- analyse condition and quality of hair, scalp, nails, hand and face skin, as well as shape of the head and face;
- care for hair, scalp, nails, hairpieces, wigs, extensions and hand skin;
- prepare skin for make-up, apply make-up and paint the body and face;
- change the shape and colour of nails (manicure);
- cut hair and shave;
- change hair shape and colour, and create a hairstyle;
- make, style and fit hairpieces, wigs and extensions;
- shape beard, moustache and whiskers;
- provide for hygiene, professional counselling and business communication;

- speak and write grammatically correct and use the appropriate terminology in his/her mother tongue and in at least one foreign language;

- behave morally and ethically in accordance with human rights and ethical rules;
- protect and preserve one's own health and the health of others by providing for the safe work environment;
- protect and conserve the environment.

In addition, the holder of the certificate also upgraded his/her key professional skills and competences with key general knowledge and skills in line with national standards.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The holder of the certificate can find employment at:

- hairdresser's salons;
- theatre, opera and television houses;
- similar positions of employment, e.g. hospitals and residential homes;
- service stands, e.g. shopping centres and chemist's as a manicurist or make-up artist.
