- creatively plan and make animations in the making of an animated movie;
- put into effect one's own projects relating to simple audio and video productions;
- put into effect one's own projects retaining to simple additional video productions,
- balance a website design concept between a customer's demands and a designer's conditions;
- prepare a template as a basis for technical execution of a website;

#### Optional:

- perform site mapping, make a test copy and print format;
- employ the colour management system;
- make 2D animations;
- project a 3D model;
- animate a 3D construction;
- co-shape image and sound as well as cooperate in lighting design and simple editing of audio and video contents;
- realise designer ideas in audio and video production;
- plan, carry out and archive a simple multimedia project.

In addition, the holder of the certificate also upgraded his/her key professional skills and competences with key general knowledge and skills in line with national standards.
